入宿條件*

- 1 年齡15歲或以上精神狀況穩定的復元人士
- 2 具有一定的工作能力和有意在公開市場就業
- 3 並沒有患上傳染病，也沒有酗酒或濫用藥物
- 4 能夠自我照顧並能與其他人和睦相處
- 5 願意接受及參與個人復元訓練

*特選中途宿舍接受「次對象組別」，包括有嚴重犯罪案、暴力行為傾向的復元人士



服務內容

由專業團隊(包括專業社工、精神科護士)及前線工作人員提供住宿及支援服務，包括：

- ✓ 個人輔導及小組治療
- ✓ 社區生活技能訓練
- ✓ 健康護理及藥物訓練
- ✓ 社交康樂活動
- ✓ 家屬支援
- ✓ 朋輩支援

收費

膳宿費按照社會福利署的收費標準收取，另外根據個人選擇的活動收費。

申請手續

經由社工及康復服務單位的工作人員轉介至社署康復服務中央轉介系統，宿舍收到轉介申請後，進行收納程序，安排經評估合適的申請者入住，一般住宿期限為兩年。

退出服務手續

服務使用者及其家人可隨時申請退出服務，本會社工了解其需要並作出跟進或轉介。

此外，因應服務使用者的身體狀況或行為等轉變，本會社工經與服務使用者、其家人或有關部門社工商議後，可轉介服務使用者至更合適服務。

Half-way House

Yuet Kwan Home, Yuet Chi Home, and Yuet Hang Home are Halfway Houses with purpose-built established in August 1997. We provide residential and rehabilitation services for mental persons-in-recovery (referred to as "PIRs").

Service Objectives

Based on the "Recovery-oriented" Concept, we provide a supportive residential service that emphasizes the involvement of PIRs in various activities at multiple levels. The aim is to promote their self-exploration, develop personal strengths and abilities during the recovery journey, and learn self-help, autonomy, and responsibility, and with the support of their families and peers, foster hope, active participation and facilitate the reintegration into society.

Service Target*

- PIRs who are aged 15 or above and mentally stable
- with reasonable vocational ability and motivation for open employment
- physically healthy and free from infectious diseases, alcohol or drug addiction
- capable of self-care, able to get along with others
- willing to accept and participate in individual recovery training program

* Halfway houses with special provision to cater for sub-target group (i.e. PIRs with a history of criminal violence or assessed disposition to violence).



Service Content

A professional team comprising social workers, psychiatric nurses, and frontline staff provides residential and support services, including:

- ✓ Individual counseling and group therapy
- ✓ Health care and medication training
- ✓ Family support
- ✓ Community living skills training
- ✓ Social and recreational activities
- ✓ Peer support

Fee The fee is charged according to the standard rate set by the Social Welfare Department, with additional charges for selected activities.

Application Procedures Referrals can be made by social workers to the Central Referral System for Rehabilitation Services of the Social Welfare Department. Once we receive the referral application, an admission process is carried out to arrange suitable applicants based on assessment results. The usual duration of stay is two years.

Service Termination Procedures

If a service user and his/her family member wish to withdraw from the services, our social worker would follow up his/her withdrawal application and make referral to other suitable service(s) based on the needs of service user. In responding to the change of health conditions and behavioral changes of the service user, our social worker would discuss with the service user, his/her family and social worker of the referring office for the arrangement of more appropriate services.
